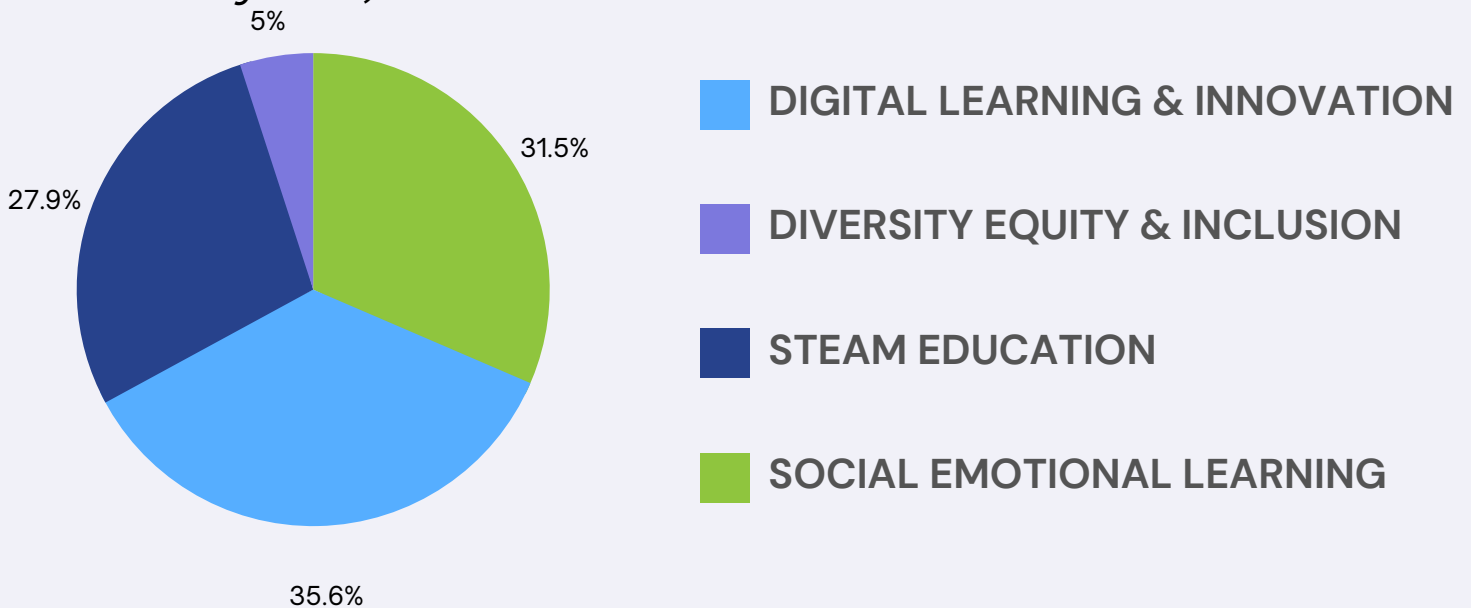

35TH ANNIVERSARY APPEAL:

In addition to the traditional school grants, this year, to celebrate MCPE's 35th Anniversary, we pledged to donate \$100,000 to the 5 Medfield schools. These donations will be split among the Medfield schools to fund a number of important and much-needed improvements within our schools, including:

Memorial School – Adding new accessible components to the playground.

Wheelock School – A complete renovation of the stage, currently in disrepair and used as storage space.

Dale Street School – A movable soundproof partition in the library, allowing for more flexible use of very limited space.

Blake Middle School – New auditorium seating to replace the original, now outdated and damaged seats.

Medfield High School – A new speaker system for the auditorium that will complete the upgrade of the stage and sound system that has been purchased over time.
